

## Policy for Use of Seafront

| Festival in excess of 1 day                           | 90 days  |

| Special Events – Celebratory/Homecoming               | 1 weeks notice<br>Consent of not less than 5 Councillors |
| Political Rally's/Events                              | Not Permitted  |
| Religious Ceremonies/Events                           | 1 weeks notice<br>Consent of 5 Councillors               |

***Please note that applications for the above shall be to the District Administrator and approval shall be subject to availability, adequate insurance and event specific conditions. The above timeframes are not applicable where a licence is required to hold an event under Part XVI of the Planning And Development Act 2000 - 2010 (as amended)***

No living accommodation permitted other than security, which shall not be used for accommodation purposes.

No storage of live animals on seafront.

Music only allowed at Bandstand area and non-residential areas.

Funfair permitted on full promenade for 7 operation days in March as part of the St. Patrick's Festival. Set up and take down days combined shall not exceed 4 days in total. Funfair vehicles and trailers not essential to operation shall not be parked in public places or roadways.

Funfair permitted on northern end of promenade for 15 days operation in July and August as part of the Bray Summerfest Festival. Set up and take down days combined shall not exceed 6 days in total. Funfair vehicles and trailers not essential to operation shall not be parked in public places or roadways.

Family/Children entertainment permitted on the middle of promenade for July and August as part of the Bray Summerfest Festival.

No casual trading other than registered markets, where temporary permits will be granted to each trader. No products can be sold that are in competition with businesses in the immediate area. No alcohol to be sold, traded or transferred on the promenade area.

To promote and facilitate non-motorised /soft water based sports operator.

To promote and enhance access for people with mobility impairment.

Programme for restoration of Seatbacks and Victorian Shelters and wrought iron lamp-posts at the granite steps.

Additional seating to be provided on the seafront.

Provide adequate funding to maintain the playground.

Promote the development of sanitary facilities and water quality improvement compatible with objectives of achieving the Blue Flag Status.

Provide adult exercise equipment.

Set sustainable fee for use of seafront for commercial events.

Protect and enhance seafront landscape.

Provide a segregated cycle track parallel to Strand Road.
