

(a) Notice of Motion in the Name of Councillor Rory O'Connor (13/09/22)

That this Municipal District invites both a TFI and Go Ahead Ireland representative in to give a presentation about our bus services.

(b) Notice of Motion in the Name of Councillor Grace McManus & Cllr. Dermot O'Brien (30/09/22)

That this Municipal District recognises the severe demand on our homeless team and all who work in housing in Wicklow County Council. We ask that a review is done and reported

back to Bray Municipal District Elected Members to ensure there is sufficient staffing in homeless services, including HAP support, to meet current and projected demand and to protect staff well-being.

(c) Notice of Motion in the name of Councillor Melanie Corrigan (03/10/22)

That this Municipal District seeks funding to complete the car park in Kilmacanogue Village, to full Tarmac and properly mark out spaces, including disability space, and for the provision of EV charging points for this area. This Car park is being relied on by the parents of the school, by the church and by regular walkers to the area, and valuable space is being lost by haphazard parking as there is no clear delineation of spaces.

(d) Notice of Motion in the name of Councillor Joe Behan (04/10/2022)

That this Municipal District plants a dividing hedge along the boundary wall between the Herbert Road and the Herbert Road car park.

(e) Notice of Motion in the name of Councillor Melanie Corrigan & Councillor Rory O'Connor (21/09/2022)

That this Municipal District commissions puts in speed reduction measures on Kilcrouney Lane, Bray in response to requests from Residents and Vulnerable Road Users in the area. This road has become a race track for cars avoiding traffic on the N11 and is severely affecting the lives of Residents on this Road.

(f) Notice of Motion in the Name of Councillor Grace McManus (30/09/22)

That this Municipal District requests that Wicklow County Council explores the potential and possibility of providing a trauma informed HAP place finding and housing support and advice service in Bray, to be provided by additional Council housing staff, and reports back on same

That this Municipal District widens the vehicular entrance to the Herbert Road car park and improves the sightlines there to improve the safety of pedestrians and motorists alike.
